The initiative to create a historical canon for St. Eustatius stems from the recognition of a significant gap in the comprehensive documentation and public understanding of the island's unique heritage, particularly its cultural, social, economic and enslaved history. Despite its pivotal role in key historical events such as the Transatlantic Slave Trade and the First Salute, there remains a lack of detailed educational resources that are accessible to the public, especially the younger generations and the broader Dutch kingdom.

The main activity of this initiative is the development of a detailed historical canon that documents and interprets St. Eustatius's past through extensive research, community engagement, and collaboration with historians, local experts, and cultural institutions. This process includes gathering oral histories, conducting archival research, and integrating diverse perspectives to ensure a multi-faceted representation of the island's history. The project will result in the creation of various educational and promotional materials, including an online platform, printed publications, and interactive learning modules aimed at schools and the general public.

The primary goal of this initiative is to enhance the cultural identity and heritage awareness among residents of St. Eustatius and to educate both local and international audiences about the island's historical significance. By making this information widely available and easily accessible, the project also aims to foster a greater appreciation and understanding of the island's contributions to global history. Additionally, this initiative seeks to promote heritage tourism, which can provide economic benefits to the local community and ensure the preservation of St. Eustatius's cultural assets for future generations. Through these efforts, the project not only aims to document and celebrate St. Eustatius's history but also to inspire a deeper connection to heritage and an informed engagement with the past.

The intended end result of the project is to create a comprehensive historical canon for St. Eustatius both online & via information boards around the island. The canon aims to document the island's unique cultural, social, and enslaved history, encompassing various educational components. The project's ultimate goal is to preserve and promote

St. Eustatius's rich heritage for future generations, embedded the local cultural heritage in the school's curriculum and to support heritage tourism

1. **Preliminary Research and Planning:** Forming a project team, establishing partnerships, and conducting an initial literature review. Expected duration: 4 months.
2. **Community Engagement and Oral Histories:** Gathering oral histories and local stories through community meetings and training volunteers. Expected duration: 2 months.
3. **Comprehensive Research and Data Compilation:** Conducting in-depth archival research and integrating oral histories to create a cohesive narrative. Expected duration: 3 months.
4. **Writing and Editing:** Ensuring the historical canon's accuracy and inclusivity through a peer review process. Expected duration: 4 months.
5. **Publication and Distribution:** Developing and publishing the historical canon online and creating educational materials. Expected duration: 6 months.
6. **Promotion and Education:** Launching promotional campaigns and distributing educational materials to raise public awareness. Expected duration: 4 months

The activities will be executed over a span of 24 months, segmented into six phases. Each phase has specific deliverables and timelines as outlined in the project plan. These phases ensure a structured and timely execution of the project, from research and documentation to publication and promotion

3. **Forming New Coalitions:** Collaborating with local stakeholders, historians regionally, and educational institutions globally to ensure a comprehensive and inclusive portrayal of the island's history.
4. **Exploring New Opportunities:** The project sets a precedent for how heritage can be documented and promoted, potentially inspiring similar initiatives in other regions or contexts

The project organization will involve a diverse team of stakeholders including the local community & organizations, Regional historians, archaeologists, and global educational institutions. This multi-stakeholder approach ensures a broad range of insights and expertise, enhancing the project's comprehensiveness and accuracy. Collaborations with national archives around the world and museums not only aid in the research but also in the eventual dissemination of the historical canon, ensuring that the project is deeply integrated with existing cultural and educational infrastructure

13. Omschrijf in welke mate en op welke wijze vrijwilligers worden ingezet voor de uitvoering van het initiatief.

Volunteers play a crucial role in the successful implementation of the St. Eustatius historical canon initiative, contributing significantly across various stages of the project. Their involvement is designed to leverage local knowledge and community participation, which are essential for capturing the rich and diverse heritage of St. Eustatius.

Recruitment and Training: Volunteers are primarily recruited from the community, including schools. However we also have to call on volunteers globally as this is explained in point 2 Archival Research Special efforts are made to engage young people to ensure a diverse range of perspectives in the project. Once recruited, volunteers receive training in oral history collection techniques, archival research methods, and community engagement strategies. This training not only equips them with the necessary skills to assist in the project but also enhances their personal development and understanding of their cultural heritage.

Roles and Responsibilities:

1. **Oral History Collection:** Volunteers are integral to gathering oral histories from local residents, particularly elders who hold memories and stories that are not recorded elsewhere. They conduct interviews, manage recording equipment, and help with initial transcriptions.
2. **Archival Research:** Call for Volunteers globally to conduct archival research effort, which is crucial due to St. Eustatius's fragmented historical records resulting from its colonial past and changing sovereignty. Since the island's history is documented not only in Dutch archives and the Dutch Antilles due to the change of colonial power our history is also recorded by the British, French, and even American.
3. **Community Outreach and Education:** Volunteers help organize and run public workshops, exhibitions, and educational sessions that aim to raise awareness about the project and the importance of heritage preservation. They serve as liaisons between the project team and the community, helping to garner support and enthusiasm for the initiative.
4. **Promotional Activities:** To promote the project and its outcomes, volunteers participate in social media campaigns, distribution of promotional materials, and organization of public events.

Support and Recognition: To acknowledge their contributions, volunteers are given certificates of participation, and outstanding contributions are highlighted in project reports and at public events. The project also provides volunteers with opportunities for networking and professional development through workshops and interactions with experts in the field.

Dissemination Strategy

1. Digital Platform and Online Archive:

- **Action:** Host the Cannon on interactive website [Canon of the Netherlands - Canon van Nederland](#) as well as consider creating a stand alone website that shares all the finding also the ones that do not make the cannon framework including multimedia content such as oral histories, digitized documents, and thematic essays.
- **Target Audience:** Local cultural heritage education , academics, researchers, heritage professionals, and the general public interested in Caribbean history and heritage.

2. Publications:

- **Purpose:** To provide in-depth analysis and discussion of the findings.
- **Action:** Produce a series of articles and a comprehensive final report detailing the research methodologies, findings, and historical narratives developed through the project. These can be submitted to both academic journals and popular magazines focused on history and culture.
- **Target Audience:** Academic institutions, heritage organizations, and cultural enthusiasts.

3. Workshops and Seminars:

- **Purpose:** To engage directly with heritage professionals and the public.
- **Action:** Organize workshops and seminars both locally in St. Eustatius and at international heritage conferences. These events will focus on the methodologies used in the project, such as oral history collection and archival research across different jurisdictions, and discuss how these approaches can be applied in other contexts.
- **Target Audience:** Local Community, Heritage professionals, educators, and students.

4. Educational Materials and Curriculum Integration:

- **Purpose:** To ensure the project has a lasting impact on heritage education.
- **Action:** Develop educational materials based on the historical canon that can be integrated into school curricula not only in St. Eustatius but also in other parts of the Netherlands and potentially in schools in related historical regions.
- **Target Audience:** Educators, school administrators, and educational policymakers.

- **Purpose:** To share insights and best practices with peers working under the Faro Convention.
- **Action:** Regularly present project updates and findings in the Faro network newsletters and online forums. Participate in Faro network meetings and symposia to discuss project outcomes and their implications for heritage practice.

- **Target Audience:** Faro network members, cultural heritage NGOs, and policymakers.

6. Media Outreach:

- **Purpose:** To raise public awareness and promote the project's findings via social media
- **Action:** Utilize press releases, local and international media interviews, and social media campaigns to highlight significant discoveries and stories from the project.
- **Target Audience:** The general public, media outlets, and online communities interested in history and heritage.

Evaluation and Feedback
